Beautiful motorvlet with aft cabin and spacious cockpit. The boat has many stainless steel and chrome accents. This makes her a feast for the eyes. The cleanliness of the engine room and the materials which are used are striking. It is clearly visible that a technician has put a lot of his knowledge into this ship. The installation of the on-board electrical system looks professional. What is striking about the lantern mast is that it is both foldable and extendable. At the front is a table with two longitudinal benches that can also serve as two single berths. Then the galley and opposite the toilet. Midships is the steering position located in a spacious open/covered cockpit with a few more seats. The aft cabin has 2x 1-persons berths. This is a ready-to-go boat that you can enjoy for many years to come.
